5.1 CBFCO Report

- Busy year for lighting
- Road House Fire Nothing came out of it. Invoice for refreshments to come through.
- Bungulla is still an issue, This year Shire will send a notice in relation to Fire Breaks and follow up if not compliant, Shire will then undertake the work and on charge to land holder.
- Yorky Rock attendance, Thanks to Swanny, Thanks for Parks and Wildlife for coming out. Thanks for those who attend. Thanks to the Shire for providing food.
- There was a suspicion fire near the tip, Unsure of what started it. Unsure if reported to 000.

5.2 DCBFCO Report

 Discussed Esperance Fires, It will be interesting to see what comes out of it following the fatality and the new WHS laws with the LG.

5.3 CESM Report

- Number of Incidents this year, 17 in total for the year. In comparison, Tammin averages 5-6 a year normally, A lot attributed to Lightning.
- The number could have also gone up as more people are calling 000, this is great to see. This will help us secure funding and appliances.
- This season has been busy but lots of little fires that have been put out rather quickly, I think the biggest was Yorky rock, Thanks to everyone who helped out at that one.
- Respirators have been issued at the last BFAC, still have some in stock for those requiring them.
- Training 36 out of 43 members have been trained, CESM to provide competency report to Shire and FCOs.
- I would like to conduct Ground Controller training to be able to use the water bombers when CESM is unavailable.
- Issued the DCBFCO with a Mobile as per LGGS
- Basic training will be held in September, Training can now be done online.
- FCO course to run 4th of September CESM to provide report as there was lots of discussion around who had done this course already.

7.1 Post Season Debrief

Chair - A lot of this has been covered in the previous reports, there haven't been any large fires for Tammin and most of them have been dealt with pretty quickly.

All parties agreed.

7.2 Restricted Burning Period/Prohibited Burning Period (RBT/PBT)

Listed for discussion on current Restricted and Prohibited Burning times for the 2024/25 firebreak notice

Restricted Burning Period:

15th October 2024 to 31st October 2024

Prohibited Burning Period:

1st November 2024 to 14th February 2025

Restricted Burning Period:

15th February 2025 to 15th March 2025

The above dates can be modified by up to a maximum of 14 days as required should seasonal conditions warrant.

The above dates were considered by the group and no changes proposed.

7.3 Burning Restrictions

7.3.1 Prohibited Burning Easter Period

Recommendation for the Prohibition of burning during the Easter weekend.

- Good Friday 15th April
- Easter Sunday 17th April
- Easter Monday 18th April

7.3.2 Prohibited Burning before 12pm, 25th April

Recommendation for the Prohibition of burning between the hours or 12:00am (midnight) and 12:00pm (midday) while ANZAC day ceremonies are taking place.

The above additional burning restrictions were discussed and considered by the group not to be necessary.

7.4 Bush Fire Exercise/Training

As per CESM Report – Training will be held in September prior to the next bushfire season. Training is also available online and a link will be sent out for seasonal workers.

ITEM 8 FURTHER MATTERS FOR DISCUSSION

Mr B Jones asked if they could use the Airstrip for water bombing operations. CESM discussed the potential to use it, however, stated there is set requirements and he was happy to explore them and will get back to Mr Jones
