

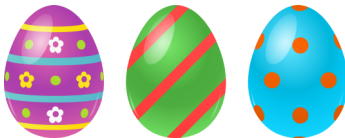

- Any inflamed skin sores that do not heal

Community Achievement Awards 2018



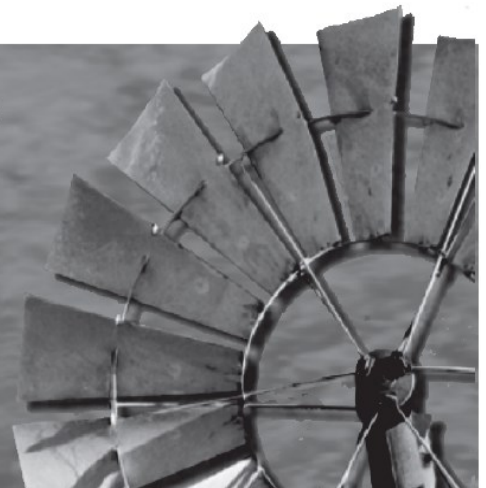

MAIN ROADS WA – UPCOMING ROADWORKS ON GREAT EASTERN HIGHWAY WITHIN THE TOWNSITE OF TAMMIN BETWEEN STATION ROAD AND LITTLE UNDERWOOD ROAD

Main Roads Western Australia will be shortly undertaking roadworks on Great Eastern Highway within the town site of Tammin between Station Road and Little Underwood Road.

We wish to advise that works are scheduled to commence between 6 March and 7 April 2018 although this may be subject to change. Electronic message boards will be placed in town with current timings. Works will be carried out between 6am and 6pm daily.

Traffic management will be in place during the works. Road users should be aware that they may experience delays however we will endeavour to maintain traffic flow through the area at all times.

For the safety of road users and road workers, speed limit restrictions will apply. Road users are urged to slow down when approaching the worksite, obey all signs and signals and show courtesy to other road users. Traffic controllers will be positioned to ensure the safety of pedestrians during the works.

Please be aware that the works will involve large moving machinery and hot bitumen products. Please exercise care and caution as there may be some loose material/stones or hot bitumen on the road at times. All efforts will be made to reduce noise levels.

We apologise for any inconvenience that the works may cause.

Restricted Burning Period, Firebreaks & Harvest Vehicle Movement Bans.

Restricted burning period: 15th October 2017—31st October 2017 (Burning permit required)

Prohibited burning period: 1st November 2017—14th February 2018 (**NO** burning permitted)

Restricted burning period: 15th February 2018— 15th March 2018 (Burning permit required)

All **firebreaks** must be prepared on or before the **1st November 2017** (or within 14 days of you becoming the owner / occupier of a property, should this be after that date) and maintained clear of flammable material up to and including the 1st day of April 2018.

Harvest and vehicle movement bans will be applied by the Chief Bush Fire Control Officer when weather conditions indicate it is necessary.

A text message will be sent out to registered mobile phones.

Round 3 has opened - Agriculture and Aquaculture Entrepreneurship Program

If you live in regional Western Australia, work in agriculture or aquaculture and you have a new idea, invention, technology or practice that you want to investigate, you may be eligible for the WA Government's Agriculture and Aquaculture Entrepreneurship Program. The program offers scholarships of up to \$30,000 which can be used for travel to research international or Australian best practice, as well as for local commercialisation, testing and training. Successful projects are expected to offer a commercial benefit to WA businesses and an economic return to WA if the innovation is adopted (such as jobs growth or industry development in regional areas).

- A third round of funding was announced on 27 February 2018 by Hon. Dave Kelly MLA, Minister for Science and Hon. Alannah MacTiernan MLC, Minister for Regional Development.
