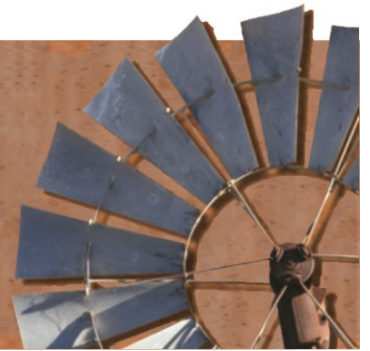

Financial Support Applications

Have you been selected to represent the State or Nation in interstate or international championships, competitions or significant cultural, academic or community service programs? You can seek financial assistance from the Shire of Tammin for travel and accommodation expenses.

The eligibility criteria for assessing financial support applications is:

- Only residents of the Shire of Tammin are eligible to apply.
- Applicants must be selected to represent Western Australia or Australia in the area of sport, arts, cultural or educational activities.
- Applications must be supported either by the relevant governing body of sport or the state/federal/voluntary organisation supporting the activity.
- There must be a demonstrated selection process which entitles the applicant to represent the state or national body or activity.
- Only one application per financial year may be funded for any one individual.
- A maximum of \$500 per year will be funded per family.
- Funds will only be provided towards travel or accommodation expenses.
- Priority will be given to applicants who have demonstrated initiative and endeavour in raising funds for themselves.
- The maximum grant that may be awarded in this category is \$200 for interstate travel and \$300 for international travel.

If you think you are eligible, please send a letter to the Shire of Tammin along with supporting documents. If Council deem your request suitable, the Shire will be in touch with further information.

Burning Period

The restricted burning period has come to an end effective from 15th March 2018. Please remember that common sense is appreciated in this period where the weather does still get hot and windy so please do not attempt to light fires to destroy garden refuse or rubbish if conditions are windy. Have a garden hose connected to a tap and water running while burning is carried out. Do not leave the fire unattended at any time. The bigger the fire, the greater the risk of sparks causing a fire to escape.
