Reseal of Roads

In the next few weeks some 6.34 km of Shire roads will be resealed.

This involves 3.17 km on the Tammin/Wyalkatchem Rd commencing 17.8 km north of town and a further 3.17 km on Goldfields Rd starting some 7 km from Tammin.

Two Way Tipper

Tenders will shortly be called for the supply of a second hand 11m³ two way tipper and the sale/trade-in of the Shire's Mitsubishi truck. A change over cost of \$195,000 has been provided for in the current budget.

Harvest and Vehicle Movement Ban

Farmers will be well aware of the need to have harvest bans during the season! For the festive season Council has again invoked its powers under regulation 38C of the Bush Fires Regulations to set down a harvest and vehicle movement ban in paddocks (except for the purpose of feeding and watering of stock), for Christmas Day, Boxing Day and New Years' Day (25 & 26 December and 1 January).

Council Meetings

Council has once again set down its meeting schedule for the next 12 months.

Meetings will be held as usual commencing at 2 pm on the third Thursday of each month with the exception of January when there will be no meeting. All will be held in the Council Chamber with the exception of September when Council will make its annual pilgrimage to the Yorkrakine Hall.

Tammin Hall Refurbishment

Some of our readers may be wondering when the hall refurbishment works are going to be completed. Actually, there are several stages and the outstanding projects include kitchen renovations, painting and carpet replacement in the lesser hall and exterior painting to both halls.

Unfortunately the builder has other commitments through to Christmas but will be back in Tammin in January to help us spend our Royalties for Regions windfall.
